“A Church Without Walls” Expanding Ministry to the South Shore Communities

As October 2007 marks the Silver Anniversary of Jubilee Christian Church International, founder, Bishop G.A. Thompson, is walking in his vision of establishing a church that is recognized as more than a beautiful building but having the congregants see themselves as “the church.” Twenty-five years ago, 80 pioneers launched out into the deep with Pastors Gilbert and Yvonne Thompson holding the first worship service at the Bradford Hotel in Boston. Now a multi-cultural teaching ministry of over 7,000 members, Jubilee celebrates the opening of their second location, **Jubilee Christian Church Stoughton** on Sunday, September 9, 2007.

The church purchased the 11.6 acre site from the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Greater Boston in 2005 for the purpose of expanding the ministry to the South Shore communities. The church renovated the existing structure, which housed the former Our Lady of the Rosary parish, to include an 850 seat sanctuary, children’s teaching area, gymnasium, and nursery. With the main campus located in Boston, MA, Jubilee’s vision is to be “A Church Without Walls”. The vision seeks to empower congregants to do the work of ministry in their everyday lives and develop spiritual strength, economic empowerment, social responsibility, political understanding and cultural awareness in the community. The Church is creating economic strength through career training and business assistance in the establishing of Christian business.

In recent years, Jubilee started its own record label and built an in-house recording studio “Axiom Entertainment” and opened Sanctuary Inc, a diverse bookstore now in three locations: Boston, Needham and Stoughton. The Jubilee-Nehemiah Building is a \$9 million office building in Boston’s Dudley Square and is the first new retail construction in the Dudley Station area in over 30 years. The Church also owns 25 acres of land on Cummings Highway in Boston, MA. This land is the largest piece of privately owned property in Boston and is the future location of a 3,500 – 5,000 seat sanctuary.

Located at 1278 Park St. (Route 27), Stoughton, MA, **Jubilee Christian Church Stoughton** will open the doors of the church on Sunday morning, September 9th with two services; 9am and 11:30am. All are invited to come and worship, *there’s room for you.*
